

RESOLUTION NO: 2011-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CEDAR KEY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT; AMENDING THE DISTRICT'S RULES REGARDING METERS FOR IRRIGATION; PROVIDING INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CODIFIER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Cedar Key Water and Sewer District owns and operates a water and wastewater system as part of a combined and integrated water and wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, the District provides potable water and wastewater treatment services to customers within its geographical boundaries as established by the Legislature of the state of Florida; and,

WHEREAS, in order for the District to provide high-quality water and wastewater services, it is necessary that rates be charged for such services that are sufficient to meet all of the obligations of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District has an obligation to insure that sufficient revenues are generated to cover all existing and anticipated expenditures for the water and wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, the District finds that it is fair, equitable, and a benefit to its customers to allow, if certain conditions are met, the use of meters on which neither sewer charges or capital facility charges are imposed

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CEDAR KEY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT:

Section 1. Section 4.02 of the codified District Resolutions is amended to read as follows:

4.02 Requests for Service

- A. General.** All requests for service shall be made by submitting a formal application for water and/or wastewater service to the District. The initial application will be reviewed by the District to determine the apparent feasibility and requirements for providing service.
- B. Application Forms.** All applicants for service shall complete and submit the Form "Application for Service" for either water and/or wastewater service (Form AFS-93A, Chapter 4, Laws of Cedar Key Water & Sewer District).
- C. Additional Water Connections.** ~~Because the District cannot know for certain how water that has passed through a meter will be used once it is on private property, all water service connections on a parcel with a sewer connection shall be billed for sewer service. There shall be no exceptions to this rule for connections that are said to be solely for irrigation or other such purposes. A customer may obtain a meter for irrigation or other purposes, on which neither sewer charges nor capital facility charges shall be imposed, if the following conditions are met:~~

1. If there is a use on the property which has a connection to the sewer system, there is a primary meter for that use on which sewer charges are imposed.
2. The customer agrees to install a back-flow preventer on the line of the new meter.
3. The customer agrees to pay the following:
 - a. The applicable meter charge as set forth in this code.
 - b. The standard rates for water as set forth in this code.
 - c. An initial service charge of \$25 to cover an initial inspection of the meter after installation and connection to the irrigation system or other use for the water.
 - d. An annual service charge of \$25 for the District to conduct an annual inspection of the meter to insure that it has not been connected to any use connected to the sewer system.

Section 2. Amendment and Codification. In Section 1 above, language underlined shall be added; language struck through shall be deleted. The changes in Section 1 above shall be incorporated into the District's codified resolutions.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon final adoption.
